Who Should Apply

Undergraduate students in upper-division standing with a GPA of 2.0 or graduate students. Please contact the IR Department to declare your intent to register for the certificate at ir@sfsu.edu.

Upon advisement

1. The student must pay the CAP application fee (\$7.00) for the award of the certificate online via the Student Center.
2. The student prepares a Certificate Approved Program (CAP) Form and submits the form and unofficial transcript(s) as evidence to the certificate advisor (and/or chair) for an approval signature.
3. The chair confirms all requirements for the certificate have been completed by signing the CAP form and submits the CAP form to Khaled Ezzat in Graduate Studies.

Processing Notes

- CAP forms submitted through DocuSign are preferred.
 - Students can attach a receipt of payment to the DocuSign envelope.
 - Forms routed outside of DocuSign must be submitted by the academic department directly to Khaled Ezzat (khaled@sfsu.edu) via email.
